## Plan Actions:

- Meet at pre-arranged location and discuss actions
- Carry out actions (e.g. check on vulnerable neighbours)
- Report back to plan co-ordinator
- Liaise with Local Authority Emergency Planner if assistance required (i.e. help from voluntary sector such as 4x4 Response)
